

**Translation of dairy research for the benefit of Scottish dairy industry**

The Hannah Dairy Research Foundation is considering an initiative to improve the translation of dairy research for the benefits of Scottish dairy industry. The first stage in this is a review of what stakeholders consider would benefit their business.

HDRF is commissioning this review up to a maximum cost of £20,000 which should include:

- Brief review of successful initiatives in UK and abroad.
- Survey of key stakeholders including progressive farmers, veterinary surgeons, milk buyers and processors, supply industry.
